

Bargh Wood



About the wood...

Bargh Wood is around half a mile from Stainforth and can be accessed via the Ribble Way. It is a native broadleaf woodland with sweeping views towards Pendle Hill and Pen-y-Ghent, creating vital habitat for wildlife.

4,900 trees have been planted including Sessile Oak, Rowan, Holly, Downy Birch, Alder, Scots Pine, Quick Thorn and Willow - all ideal species for the exposed site.

The woodland is also part of YDMT's Plastic Free Woodlands project, supported by the European Outdoor Conservation Association, and 100 of the trees have been planted with alternative tree guards.

The woodland was also part of Stories in Stone, a scheme of conservation and community projects in the Ingleborough area, with support from the United Bank of Carbon.

How to get there...

Bargh Wood is around half a mile on foot from the National Park's Car Park at Stainforth.

Park at the Car Park, turn right and then take the path on the left before the road heads to Malham. Go through the gate and follow the very steep path up the hill (Ribble Way).

Bargh Wood is over the second stile and has How Beck running through it.

PLEASE NOTE: The woodland itself is not on open access land, but does have a footpath running through it. We would appreciate it if you could stick to the footpath. There is no access for vehicles and the walk up, whilst pleasant with great views, is steep.

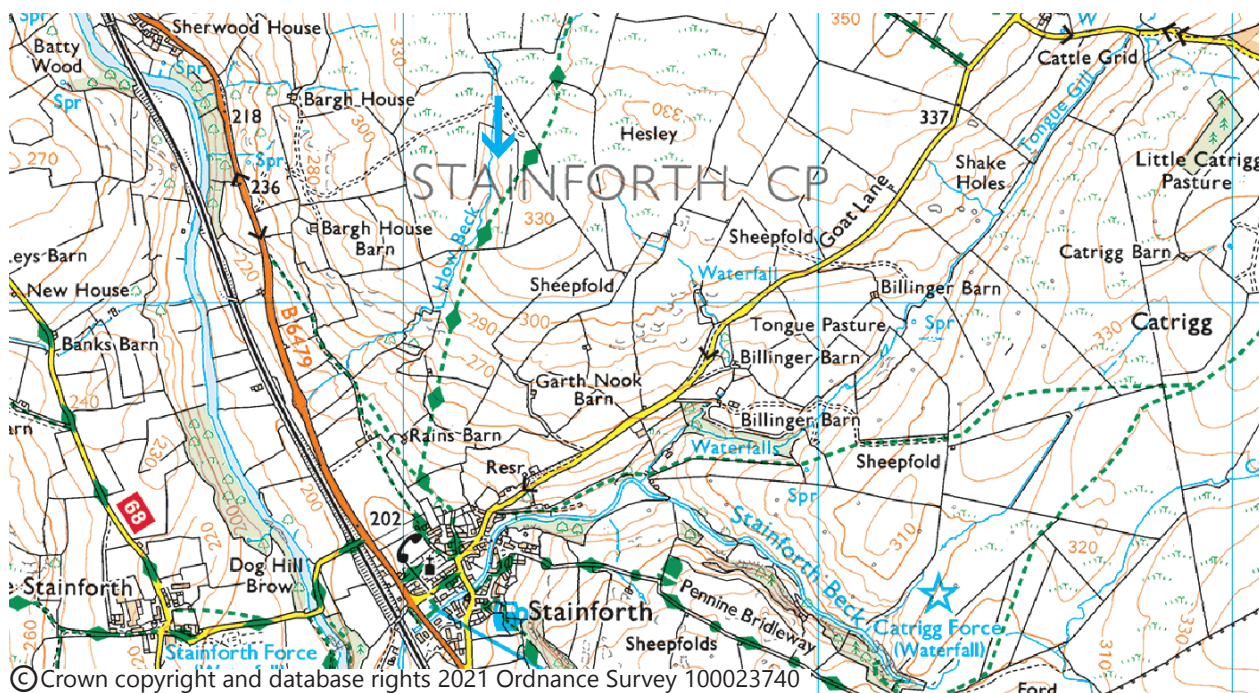
