### **Project Delivery**

- Manage the Discoveries on Your Doorstep steering group.
- Lead on stakeholder engagement, partnership development and consultation. Liaise with internal and external partners on Public Health, nature conservation developments and health improvement programmes.
- Lead on the development of internal and external communications with relevant stakeholders.
- Lead on the design and delivery of Public Health and related government campaigns which support physical activity, active travel, wellbeing, green space and air quality, as determined by related communications plans.

### Partnership/Corporate Working

- Participate in relevant internal and external working groups/projects, services, and initiatives.
- Attend relevant professional meetings and conferences.

## Systems and information

- As the post develops increased public health knowledge and skills, there will be an expectation the post holder will lead on needs assessments, audits, evaluations and monitoring of public health programmes and services.
- Monitor, evaluate and report the impact of the Programme, specifically in relation to access, biodiversity, physical activity, active travel behaviours, and air quality/traffic.
- Support the dissemination of practice developments/research findings to facilitate evidence-based practice.
- Contribute to the analysis and evaluation of health data and effectiveness of public health and nature conservation initiatives and programmes.
