About the wood...

Pasture Woodland is a new native wood above Grassington in Wharfedale.

It was planted in 2004-06 with 5,500 native broadleaved trees, predominately ash, but also oak, birch, rowan, holly, hazel, hawthorn and willow. Tree guards have been used to protect the trees from rabbit damage.

How to get there...

At the top (northern end) of Grassington Main Street, continue straight ahead along Moor Lane until reaching the Royal Oak Furniture Company. Turn left down the drive to access the site.

There is a public footpath from the town which runs through the woodland and eventually meets Moor Lane further up the hill from the entrance to the Royal Oak Furniture Company.

Parking is available at the site.

Please Note: The woodland is situated on private land - please keep to the footpath in the wood.
