# Harrison's Woodland

### About the wood...

This is our 2011-13 Supporter Woodland, covering an area of 6.3 hectares. A mixture of native broadleaf species have been planted, including large proportions Hawthorn (15%), Oak (16%), Ash (16%) and Downy Birch (10%), along with Alder, Rowan, Holly, Bird Cherry and Blackthorn. In total 6750 trees have been planted on the site.

It adjoins an area of woodland that YDMT planted in 2009 called Parlour Barn Wood, and it also links to hedgerows and other smaller areas of native broadleaf woodland in the area, allowing insects, animals, wildflowers, lichens and other wildlife to move between the woodland areas and thrive.

## How to get there...

From A59 Eastbound (Skipton - Harrogate). At Fewston Reservoir (just after the church on your right) turn left onto Hardisty Hill, signposted Pateley Bridge. Continue past the Stone House Inn, and after approximately 1 mile turn right onto Braithwaite Lane and continue to the T junction. The track leading to the woodland is directly opposite, signposted Parlour Barn Kennels and Cattery.

#### From Greenhow.

Opposite the church turn onto Duck Street Lane, signposted Blubberhouses/Harrogate. Continue for 3miles. Turn left onto Braithwaite Lane, continue to T-junction. Take the track opposite signposted Parlour Barn Kennels and Cattery.


