

Longridge Woodland

About the wood...

Set high up on the hillside in Bishopdale, this woodland enjoys beautiful views of the dale between West Burton and Cray.

The woodland covers an area of 41 hectares (approx. 100 acres) and was planted with around 39,600 native trees during the winter of 2013/14. The trees are visible on the hillside as you travel along the B6160 from Cray to West Burton.

A mixture of Alder, Downy Birch, Rowan, Hazel, Field Maple, Wild Cherry, Holly, Hawthorn, Whitebeam, Blackthorn, Dogwood, Lodgepole Pine and Scots Pine have been planted with individual tree guards to protect them from harsh weather and rabbit damage.

How to get there...

Longridge Wood is near to the B6160, approximately 8 miles from Aysgarth and 4 miles from Buckden.

When approaching from the south on the B6160, the woodland is visible on your left, set high up on the hillside.

Please Note:

There are no public rights of way within the immediate vicinity of the woodland. This is private land which is not open to the public (except on official YDMT woodland open days).

The footpath on the opposite side of the dale offers a good view of the woodland.
