About the wood...

Planted in 2006, Thornbrook wood at Thornton in Lonsdale covers 3.75 hectares and is planted with 7975 native broadleaved trees and shrubs.

Species include Oak, Rowan, Alder, Birch, Wild Cherry, Field Maple, Goat Willow, Crab Apple, Holly, Hazel, Guelder Rose, Hawthorn, Blackthorn and Dogwood. The trees have been individually protected with tree guards to prevent rabbit damage.

The trees are now over 5 feet tall and the site is starting to feel like a well-established woodland, home to a healthy variety of flora and fauna.

How to get there...

From the East.

Follow the A65 through Ingleton. Thornbrook wood is situated opposite the Country Harvest coffee shop.

From the West.

Follow the A65 from Kirby Lonsdale towards Ingleton. Thornbrook wood is situated opposite the Country Harvest coffee shop. The Yorkshire Dales Millennium Trust is a small charity doing big things to support every aspect of life in the Yorkshire Dales. 
