Role Title: Countryside worker apprentice.

Fixed 18 month term, 39 hours a week including the requirement for college. You will need to be willing and able to attend college in Skipton one day per fortnight. Transport costs will be met by us for this.

The scheme is for 16-24 year olds and those who do not already have a qualification in a similar field. The successful applicant will have a positive attitude to work, the ability to use their initiative and able to work as part of a team. There is plenty of training and investment available for the right person.

The vocational qualification will be assessed at work and at college. Attendance at college will be an average of one day a fortnight for the first year of the scheme. A timetable will be set before the start of the course and may vary seasonally.

Trainee progress will be monitored on a three-monthly basis by college staff, employer and YDMT staff. They will visit the workplace and talk to apprentices and supervisors. This meeting will give the opportunity to discuss the training and any concerns.

Salary will be based on experience and age of the candidate but will be a minimum of the national apprenticeship wage.
