## Job Purpose:

1. Diversify and grow Yorkshire Dales Millennium Trust Consultants Limited (YDMTCL) as a multidisciplinary consultancy to directly support the charity's vision.
2. Leadership of our Landscape Design Team to raise commercial income through the delivery of green space and access projects aligned to our strategy.
3. Deliver new commercially profitable projects that create meaningful benefits for communities, wildlife and the landscape of the Dales and surrounding areas.

## Our Organisation:

Yorkshire Dales Millennium Trust (YDMT) is a charity doing big things to help to protect and enhance the People, Landscape and Wildlife of the Dales. Our strategy is centre around building partnerships that increase the scale and pace of nature recovery.

For 27 years we have delivered diverse and inspirational projects, helping to plant 1.6 million trees and securing the future of more than 850 hectares of wildflower hay meadows, creating habitats for our wildlife and combatting climate change. We are passionate about inspiring disadvantaged groups and future generations to care for this special area.

Yorkshire Dales Millennium Trust Consultants Limited is the trading arm of the charity and currently delivers landscape design services with a team of two Landscape Architects. The team design and deliver solutions for urban, rural and community regeneration, using their technical knowledge and experience to deliver high quality green space projects that boost wellbeing, climate resilience and biodiversity. YDMTCL has its own board of directors, including YDMT trustees that help to shape strategy, direction and ensure alignment with YDMT's strategy and values. YDMTCL is in its infancy, currently turning over less than £100,000 per annum, we hope to double this over the next two to three years. All profits are gifted to the charity.

We are seeking a commercially minded environmental professional to lead and grow YDMTCL, the trading arm of the charity. The role will focus on expanding the consultancy services, developing new income streams, and supporting the Landscape Design Team to deliver high quality projects for communities, nature and climate resilience.

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We welcome applicants from environmental, landscape, ecology, land management or related sectors who have strong business development skills. Your experience and area of expertise should build on our existing consultancy skills promoting wider opportunities and interdisciplinary collaboration capabilities.

This is a commercially focused environmental leadership role with flexibility around technical background. The role will be 90% focused on working for the trading company with 10% of time to support the charity.

## How we work:

## Main Responsibilities:

### Leadership of our Landscape Design Team

- a. Effectively managing the Landscape Design Team, support preparation and delivery of bids and tenders, ensuring that work tendered is competitively priced, and monitor income targets and expenditure budgets.
- b. Support the growth of revenue from Landscape Design services, increasing the number of major projects and working to develop a pipeline of future projects that align with our strategic aims.
- c. Work with the team to develop a multidisciplinary approach that adds value to and complements our Landscape Design Offer. Raising the profile of YDMTCL and developing appropriate marketing activity to secure new business.
- d. Support the overall development of staff, role modelling our values and behaviours

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## Diversify and grow YDMT Consultants

Lead the business development and management of YDMTCL to achieve increased revenue growth and profitability:

- e. Identify and deliver new projects, including but not limited to exploring the provision of ecological services to create a new income streams, primarily undertaking specialist ecological surveys (depending on skillset), with scope to pursue projects linked to your expertise.
- f. Explore new revenue-generating approaches leveraging nature markets to create a pipeline of projects that could deliver nature-based solutions; working closely with our partners and building relationships with landowners.
- g. Lead on YDMTCL's strategic and financial planning; including budgeting, and reporting, ensuring alignment with Trust financial systems and providing quarterly updates to Trading Board Directors. Ensure consultancy aligns with Trust values and long-term strategy.
- h. Building collaborative partnerships that identifying opportunities for new projects working with partners such as Local Authorities, National Parks, National Landscapes and NGO's.
- i. Act as a senior point of contact for the consultancy, representing the business both externally to key clients, partners and industry forums and internally within the Trust.

## General:

- a. Provide advice to our current projects and support the overall implementation of the YDMT strategy
- b. Work in accordance with YDMT policies, paying particular attention to Health and Safety policy, staying informed on relevant legislation, standards, best practice, and opportunities within the ecological, landscape design and environmental sectors.
- c. Support the monitoring and evaluation of projects to ensure that we are collecting impact data in line with our strategy. Help to ensure that we are demonstrating to stakeholders the benefits of our work.
- d. All staff members are expected to volunteer to support and assist at the occasional evening and weekend event.
