

## We are Yorkshire Dales Millennium Trust

Yorkshire Dales Millennium Trust (YDMT) is a small charity doing big things to support the people, landscape and wildlife of the Yorkshire Dales and surrounding areas.

Our inspirational projects cover areas as diverse as apprenticeships, supporting local communities, education and outreach, restoring woodlands and wildlife habitats, and improving access and understanding of this special place.

Since 1996, we have supported the planting of 1.5 million trees, restored more than 800 hectares of wildflower rich meadows and conserved the unique heritage features that make the Yorkshire Dales landscape special – like rebuilding drystone walls, restoring village halls and milestones.

We have brought more than 14,000 adults and young people from disadvantaged urban backgrounds to the Yorkshire Dales, often for the first time, to enjoy all kinds of activities and adventures in the beautiful countryside.

We know how important being outside and in nature is for health and wellbeing.

We provide training opportunities and apprenticeships for young local people to learn countryside management skills with 85 per cent going on to further education or employment.

We also help our communities make a real difference on a local scale through a programme of grants that are quickly assessed and delivered.

We have supported the planting of 1.5 million trees since 1996, transforming native broadleaf cover in the Yorkshire Dales.

We give life changing opportunities for groups from urban areas to visit the Dales for respite, health and well-being.

We know the people, landscape and wildlife of this area face many challenges - environmental, economic and social - and we have a bold ambition to extend the reach and impact of our work.

We can only do this with the dedication of our staff and their ability to go above and beyond. We are We connect young people with nature and the outdoors, allowing them to learn and understand the natural world.
