



## Yorkshire Dales Millennium Trust Challenge Events Terms and Conditions

**Please read these terms and conditions carefully. By registering for this event, you confirm that you have read, understood and accept them.**

1. The event organiser is Total Warrior. All participants must read and sign up to the Total Warrior Terms and Conditions during registration. Please visit the [Total Warrior](#) website for further information regarding registrations, cancellations and their liability policy.
2. By signing up for the Total Warrior 2026, you confirm that, to the best of your knowledge, you are sufficiently fit and healthy to take part in the event. Anyone unsure of their physical ability to take part in the event must seek medical advice from their doctor prior to the event.
3. Participants enter the event at their own risk and, so far as permitted by law, Yorkshire Dales Millennium Trust (YDMT) shall not be liable for any injury or loss to persons or their property that might occur as a result of their participation in the event.
4. Event **registration fees are non-refundable.**
5. Participants must use their best endeavours to raise the full fundraising target for the event. You should inform the YDMT team as soon as possible if you can't achieve the fundraising target. Failure to keep on track with fundraising or a lack of response to contact from the YDMT team could result in your place in the event being removed.
6. Participants should inform the YDMT team as soon as possible if they are unable to take part in the event.
7. Where a participant withdraws after the 31<sup>st</sup> March 2026, there will be an additional **cancellation fee of £15.**

8. Participants are aware that their place in an event is not confirmed until they have completed their registration with Total Warrior, and they must complete this step as soon as possible. The YDMT team will trigger this step once they have received your initial registration form and payment.
9. All donated monies collected in support of YDMT must be forwarded to the charity or returned to the individual sponsors if it transpires that you are unable to participate in the event for any reason. Monies already received by the charity will not be refunded.
10. You must abide by the [Codes of Practice issued by the Fundraising Regulator](#).
11. Event participants are classed as “in-aid-of” fundraisers. This means you are asking for money for charitable purposes independently of a charity.
12. Photography – the YDMT team will endeavour to capture images of our team during the event. Images may be used on social media and on future promotional material.
